DORSET COUNTY AA TRACK & FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS - MAY 11th 2019

The Dorset County Track & Field Championships will take place on Saturday 11th May 2019 at Kings Park Athletic Centre, Bournemouth. I am sure you appreciate that these Championships are the most important event on the County track and field calendar of the athletic year. Please note that the event, like last year, has been condensed to a single day. There are, obviously implications for younger age groups and attention should be drawn to restrictions contained in Note 3 on the entry form. A provisional timetable accompanies the entry form and a final timetable will be published on the DCAA website once entries have closed, approximately 7 days prior to the event. Competition numbers will not be sent out but will be available for collection on the competition day.

The standing of the Championships is obviously dependent upon the support and entry of as many of our talented athletes as possible and we urge you to give your support by advertising and by encouraging as many of your athletes as possible to compete. We always need more entries!
