Outdoor Gym Equipment

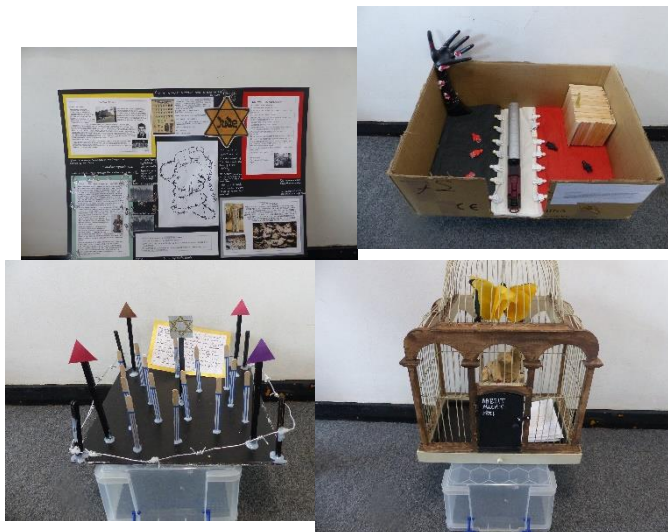
