Code club



Set up 2-factor authentication

2-factor authentication adds another layer of security to your password by asking for another piece of information. For example, you might need to enter your password and then enter a code you're sent via text message. It's much more secure as passwords alone can be guessed or cracked.

Lots of apps and sites let you use 2-factor authentication, and you should choose to use it whenever you can.
