Face Coverings

Just to remind you that all pupils, unless exempt, must have a face covering in school, and thank you to the vast majority of pupils that remember theirs on a daily basis. However, increasingly, we are having to give out approximately 12 disposable masks a day. As you can imagine, this has an environmental implication, and a cost that the school can't continue to bear so we have decided that we will charge 20p per mask. This will operate the same as forgotten lunch money, in that a note will be put in the pupil's diary, and they will need to bring in 20p the next school day and pay it back to the office.

This procedure will come into effect on Monday 30 November 2020.
