School Uniform Orders

Please be advised that if you are placing orders for hoodies and tracksuit bottoms via SWI there is currently a 2-3 week delay on delivery of these products. If you have already placed an order you should have received an email notification direct from them.

The delay is due to an increased demand for orders of outer pe kit items nationally, as students are required to attend school on PE days in the kit ready for lessons. This has subsequently led to a shortage of certain items.

The situation hasn't been helped as one of the manufacturers had to temporarily close due to having positive cases of Covid-19. Production has now resumed and they are working to resolve the backlog.

Mr Stevens is happy for pupils to wear an alternative hoodie or tracksuit bottoms if they are waiting to receive an order.
